All their personal belongings must be packed before the summer vacation.</li> <li>Drawing of lots will be held for those who wish to renew the lease.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The lease is valid from September 1<sup>st</sup> to July 31<sup>st</sup>. The accommodation fees should be paid in two installments; the 1<sup>st</sup> term is from September to February, and the 2<sup>nd</sup> term is from March to July. Residents may stay free of charge in August if they renew the lease.</li> <li>Residents may stay at the dorm during winter and summer vacations, and they can renew the lease without going through the drawing.</li> <li>Residents may check in from September 1<sup>st</sup>. Those who do not have the lease renewed must check out by July 31<sup>st</sup>.</li> <li>Residents who check out between September and June will receive no refund of the deposit.</li> </ol>	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The lease is on a semester basis.
