Regulations for Student Sports Teams to Participate in the

Off-campus Sports Competitions at I-Shou University

Ratified and promulgated by the President on September 12, 2000

Amendments to the Regulations ratified and promulgated by the President on November 1, 2010

- Article 1 To establish the system for the Sports Teams of the University to participate in the off-campus sports competitions, develop the function of the sports competitions, improve the effectiveness of sports training and win honors for the University, the *Regulations for Student Sports Teams to Participate in the Off-campus Sports Competitions at I-Shou University* (hereinafter referred to as the "Regulations") is hereby established.
- Article 2 The Regulations is applicable to the sports teams (hereinafter referred to as the "Teams") that represent the University to participate in the sports competitions with the approval of the University.
- Article 3 The aforesaid representation of the University to participate in the sports competitions may include the following competitions:
 - 1. All kinds of sports competitions held by the Ministry of Education.
 - 2. All kinds of sports competitions held by the Chinese Taipei University Sports Federation.
 - 3. All kinds of sports competitions held by national sports associations in Taiwan.
 - 4. All kinds of sports competitions approved by the President
- Article 4 The Office of Physical Education shall submit the official document issued by the organizer to relevant administrative units for countersigning and the President for approval before registering for the aforesaid sports competitions.

The selection and qualifications for the members of the Teams are as follows:

- 1. Coaches: Select PE teachers, or teachers from other departments or professionals from outside the University with expertise in specific sports.
- 2. Participants: Select by the coaches of individual sports.
- 3. Other members: Faculty may represent the coaches if the coaches are not able to participate in the competitions for some reason. The Director of the Office of Physical Education may assign responsible staffs to participate and provide assistance in relevant affairs.

Article 5 The members of the Teams shall apply for official leave or business trip in accordance with relevant regulations of the University.

Article 6 The Team members shall wear the sports outfit of the University to participate in the opening ceremony of the competitions, and they shall wear proper outfits for the sports to participate the competitions.

The Teams may apply for a maximum of 50% subsidies from the University on sports outfits, including clothes, pants and socks, and the application may be filed once only in each academic year.

Article 7 The Teams may apply for subsidies in accordance with the Regulations.

The subsidies for the sports competitions are divided into registration fee, transportation fee, accommodation fee, daily meal fee and drink cost. The approved amount of subsidies is as follows:

- 1. Registration fee: Subsidies are granted in accordance with the regulations of the sports competitions.
- 2. Transportation fee: The University provides subsidies only to participants who take public transportation. Participants shall apply for the subsidies according to the actual expenditures. The train fare is paid based on the fare of Tzu-Chiang Express, and the bus fare is paid based on the fare of Kuo-Kwang Bus or the fare of other public/civil transportations.
- 3. Accommodation fee: Participants may apply for accommodation fee when the venue is at the eastern part of Taiwan or at areas north of Chiayi. The approved amount of subsidies is as follows:

A. Taipei City: NT\$650

B. Other places: NT\$600

4. Daily meal fee:

- A. Short-distance competitions (competitions held at areas south of Tainan): NT\$200 (NT\$40 for breakfast and NT\$80 for lunch and dinner respectively).
- B. Long-distance competitions (competitions held at areas north of Chiayi and the eastern part of Taiwan): NT\$250 (NT\$50 for breakfast and NT\$100 for lunch and dinner respectively).
- 5. Drink cost: The subsidies for the team participating ball games are up to NT\$200, and the subsidies for the team participating swimming competitions are up to NT\$400. The subsidies shall be given in accordance with the actual participants listed in the game schedules.

The subsidies given to the team leaders shall be in accordance with the Regulations

- for Applications of Business Trip Allowance by Faculty Members & Staff of I-Shou University.
- Article 8 The coaches and members of each Team shall file the subsidies application and verification within 15 days after the competitions, and the results of the competitions shall be submitted to the Office of Physical Education.
- Article 9 The Regulations become effective on the third day of promulgation upon the adoption by the University Administration Council and ratification by the President.

Note: In the event of any disputes or misunderstanding as to the interpretation of the language or terms of the Regulations, the Chinese language version shall prevail.
