## Information about Service Education (I) /(II) in the 1st Semester of Academic Year 2025 (Applicable to international students whose Student No. begins with 106~112)

Section I - Fundamental Knowledge (12 hours): Available only to international students who are unable

to apply for membership to Taipei e-Campus Taking Service Education (I) & (II) requires  $12 \times 2 = 24$  hours.

- 1. Please log in to ISU Moodle (https://moodle.isu.edu.tw/) to watch videos under "Service Education-Fundamental Knowledge" for at least 12 hours, and then upload your video-watching records to the Information System (Service Education Courses → Section I).

Section II - Public Service Activities (16 hours) Taking Service Education (I) & (II) requires  $16 \times 2 = 32$  hours.

- 1. You must complete at least 16 hours of on-campus public service (administrative or academic units), but personal academic or research activities are not included. (NO hours of public service fulfilled will be recognized if you don't apply to the Student Campus Life Guidance Section at least three working days before the beginning of your service.)

Section III - Reflection and Feedback (2 hours) Taking Service Education (I) & (II) requires 2


## reflections with different content (100 words each).

- After you have completed both Section I and Section II, please log in to the Information System (Service Education Courses → Section III) to complete an experience report and a feedback questionnaire. (Your experience report will NOT be reviewed until you have completed both Section I and Section II.)
- 2. Please complete the 2<sup>nd</sup> question in the experience report with at least 100 words (not alphabets), and your feedback must be relevant to service education.
- 3. Plagiarism is strictly prohibited! If a phrase or sentence of 7 words or more in your experience report is the same as that appearing in articles or good sentences on the Internet or in the experience reports completed by other students, your experience report will be considered a plagiarized work, and you will fail the service education course in this semester and has to retake the course.

## Other Notices:

- 1. Application period for participating in public service activities: Sep. 10 (Wed.) ~ Dec. 10 (Wed.); deadline for completing public service activities: (Sep. 15~) Dec. 15 (Mon.); deadline for uploading supporting documents: Dec. 15 (Mon.).
- 2. You will not be considered passing the service education course until all the three sections are marked "Passed." You may work on Section I and Section II simultaneously, but you are not permitted to proceed to Section III until you have uploaded supporting documents of Section I and Section II to the Information System. (You may proceed to complete the experience report and the feedback questionnaire right after uploading supporting documents.)

- 3. The required hours of public service must be fulfilled during the semester in which you take the service education course. The hours of public service fulfilled will NOT be recognized or transferred to the following semesters if you don't take the service education course or apply to the Service Education Section in advance.
- 4. No hours of public service fulfilled will be recognized if the applicable rules are not adhered to. If you fail to fulfill 16 hours of public service by the deadline mentioned above, no extension will be granted, and the hours of public service you have already completed will become invalid and not be transferred to the following semesters.
- 5. Due to large student enrollment, it takes about three weeks to review your performance and documentation. You may check whether you have passed the service education course or need to upload supplementary documents in late Dec., and the exact date will be announced later.
